

DRESS CODE

Acceptable

MEN -

1. Shirts must have sleeves with collars, blade collars, mock necks or turtlenecks.
2. Tailored golf slacks, shorts, including tailored golf shorts with multiple pockets (not cargo), of a golf-appropriate length (as sold in the Pro Shop) must be worn with socks either below the ankle or of Bermuda length.
3. "Fashion forward" golf shirts (those that are styled or designed to be worn untucked) are permitted to be worn untucked but all other golf shirts must be tucked in.
4. Corporate logos are to be discreet and only permitted on apparel and not on headwear.
5. Closed footwear must be worn at all times other than fashion forward open toed footwear is permitted, such as leather sandals.

"Smart Denim" pants (not ripped, frayed, distressed, torn or faded) may be worn in the Clubhouse and on the adjacent patios. Jeans are not permitted on the golf course or any practice areas.

Acceptable

WOMEN-

1. Golf skirts, skorts, Capri pants, slacks, tailored shorts of the type sold in the Pro Shop.
2. Golf shirts, mock necks or turtlenecks, if not banded or otherwise delineated at the waist, must be worn tucked in, unless they are designed as "Fashion forward" and then are allowed to be worn untucked.
3. Sleeveless golf shirts must have approved collars.
4. Corporate logos are to be discreet and only permitted on apparel and not on headwear
5. Women are permitted to wear open toed footwear (excluding flip-flops) throughout the clubhouse

"Smart Denim" pants (not ripped, frayed, distressed, torn or faded) may be worn in the Clubhouse and on the adjacent patios but not on the golf course or any practice areas.

Caps and Hats

Ladies are permitted to wear hats and caps, in the clubhouse lounge.

Men are not permitted to wear hats inside the clubhouse. Hats and caps must be worn in the style they were intended.
