



# SUMMIT GUEST INFORMATION

It is our pleasure to welcome you to our Club, and we trust you will enjoy your time while visiting one of the finest golf clubs in Canada. In order to ensure that you have a memorable experience while at Summit, please familiarize yourself with some of the club's traditions and policies.

## CELLULAR PHONES

The uses of cellular telephones are strictly prohibited, except in the case of a medical emergency. To preserve the integrity of the Club, and out of respect for members and their guests, we ask that you please abide by the Club's policy.

- Cellular phones may be used discreetly for non-verbal communication.
- Cellular phones may be used in the parking lot or in the small meeting room dedicated in the Clubhouse for phone use.

## ARRIVAL

Upon arrival, the member hosting you will register you in the Golf Shop. Once registered, day lockers are available in the Men's and Ladies' Locker Rooms if needed. Please note that practice facilities and the golf course are not available for use, until your host has registered you.

## DRESS CODE

Proper attire is required at all time while on Club property.

### Gentlemen

- Shirts with collars are required, and must be tucked in at all times
- Hats must be worn in the forward position
- Shorts must be no more than 3" above the knee
- Short golf socks are permitted

### NOT PERMITTED

- Caps or clothing bearing logos, emblems, slogans, numbers and illustrations not related to golf
- Hooded sweatshirts
- Cargo shorts or pants (gusted pockets)
- Fitness attire including sweatpants or shorts (elastic waist)

## Ladies

- Shirts must have a collar and/or sleeves
- Tailored slack or Capri pants
- Shorts, skorts, skirts and dresses must be no shorter than 6” above the knee
- Hats must be worn in the forward position

## NOT PERMITTED

- Exercise pants, including yoga style
- Fitness attire including sweatpants and shorts (elastic waist)
- Caps or clothing bearing logos, emblems, slogans, numbers and illustrations not related to golf
- Hooded sweatshirts
- Cargo shorts or pants (gusted pockets)

## PACE OF PLAY

Summit’s enforce pace of play is that all rounds must be played in 4 hours and 15 minutes or less. This policy is strictly enforced by the Club and its TAG Marshall system.

Below are some helpful hints:

- Keep up with the group ahead, not ahead of the group behind
- Mark the scorecard on the next tee, not on the green
- Make a point of getting to your ball quickly so you have time to settle before your next stroke
- Play “Ready Golf”
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## COURSE CONDITIONS

The Club takes pride in presenting a well-conditioned championship golf course on a day to day basis. Please assist us in maintaining the conditioning by following the few practices below:

**Pull Carts:** All pull cart traffic must go around the bunker, and are not permitted to be pulled in between the green and bunker.

**Carts:** All electric carts must enter and exit the fairway through the green flags (roughly 30 yards in front of the green). All carts must stay in fairway and not be driven in the rough unless entering or exiting at designated posts. Carts must stay on the cart paths on all par 3’s.

**Divots:** Divots are to be filled with sand and seed mix and NOT to be replaced.

**Sand and Seed:** Bottles will be provided upon arrival. Refill stations are located on the golf course, holes 4, 6, 7, 9, 14, and 16.

**Ball Marks:** The Club provides complimentary divot tools, we appreciate you fixing all ball marks.

**Bunkers:** Please fully rake and smooth bunker after use. Rakes are to be left outside the bunker.
